It usually takes me 20-30 various blending trials before I reach the iteration that we bottle. I am very excited about the addition of the Aglianico and Carmenère this year as well

Winemaker Comments

King-sized aromas of briary raspberry, boysenberry and pipe tobacco roar from the glass, followed by flavors of cherry cobbler, plum, milk chocolate, mixed berry pie, and black tea leaves. This is the perfect wine to pair with all your carnivorous endeavors. Rawrghhhhhh!

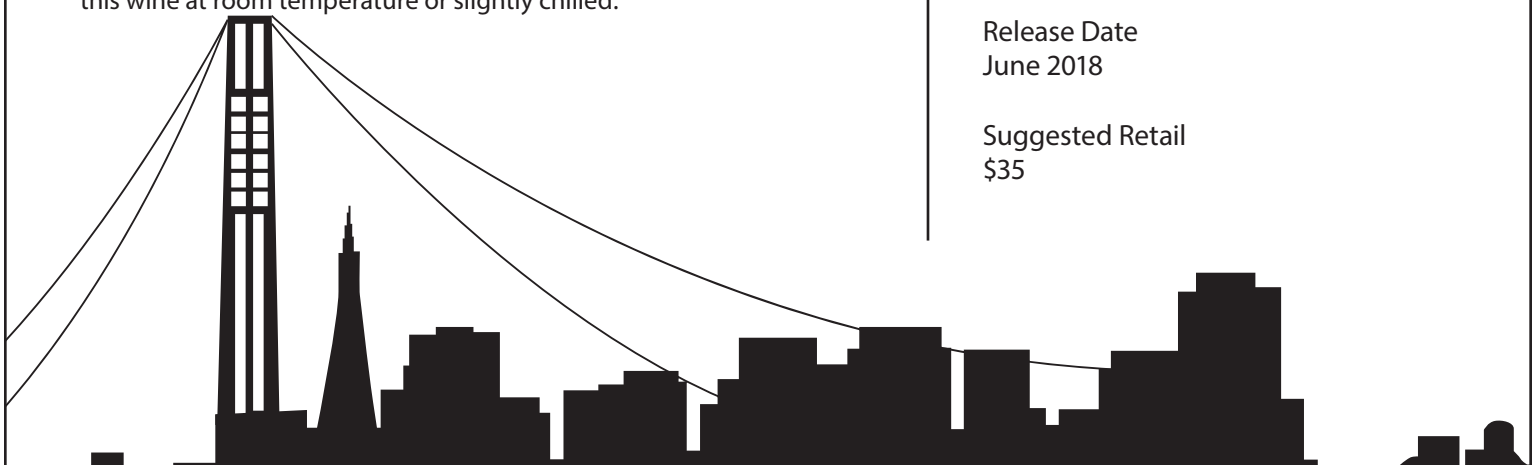
