### VINEYARD NOTES:

This Petite Sirah Vineyard is perched atop a volcanic ridge at the western end of High Valley. Located at 2250 ft. in elevation on the southwestern slopes of High Valley, the soils on this ridge are primarily broken shale characteristic of Franciscan formation (ancient seabed floor) with a light dusting of red volcanic soils intermixed. The depth and complex composition of the soil combined with our unique microclimate stress the vines, keeping our yields low.

Yeast: D80

Fermentation: 14-day fermentation in macro bins

Malolactic: Elios 1

Barrels: 10/28/2015 to 20% new French oak, 10% American oak, 70% neutral oak

Bottled: 1/2017

### WINEMAKER COMMENTS:

This wine has gorgeous acidity and shows off its volcanic terroir in the flavor profile. This young Petite Sirah boasts aromas of pomegranate, blackberry, leather, violets and white pepper followed by flavors of blueberry, plum, chalky tannin and cacao notes.

I can't wait to see how this wine continues to evolve as it ages.


