Frankie Favalora's beautiful Sophia Favalora Vineyard is located in Oakley, in Contra Costa County. This vineyard (much like Frankie) is extremely well-manicured; there's not a weed in sight. The cuttings for this vineyard come from the late Stan and Gertie Planchon's vineyard which was one of the first vineyards planted in Oakley in the 1890's.

Elegant, just like the elusive mermaid, this pretty pink wine smells like strawberry milkshake, fresh squeezed lemonade, hibiscus flower, and white pepper. Gorgeous flavors of blackberry, raspberry, peach, tangerine, Madagascar vanilla, and rose petal complete the experience. This wine is a chameleon and would be a fun one to taste in a black glass as I think it could masquerade as a red or white wine. I am super stoked about this wine! Cheers, and let the games begin.


