VINEYARD NOTES

This Zinfandel Vineyard is perched atop a volcanic ridge at the western end of High Valley Lake County. Located at 2250 ft. in elevation on the southwestern slopes of High Valley, the soils on this ridge are primarily broken shale characteristic of a geological Franciscan formation (ancient seabed floor) with a light dusting of red volcanic soils intermixed. The depth and complex composition of the soil combined with their unique microclimate stresses the vines, keeping their yields low and the fruit concentrated flavors.


