VINEYARD NOTES

Volcano Ridge Vineyard: This Zinfandel comes from Volcano Ridge Vineyard. Originally planted in 2003, Volcano Ridge (created by hundreds of eruptions from nearby Round Mountain Volcano) totals 85 acres devoted to all red varietals with numerous clones of each. At 1900-2200 ft. elevation the volcanic sands and tephra (small, fused sand pebbles) of the Konocti series make for excellent drainage and great flavors in the fruit.

Pick Date: 9/5/2016

Yeast: EC1118 Pris de Mousse

Fermentation: fermented in half ton macro bins with two punch downs per day

Malolactic: Elios 1

Barrels: 15% new French oak, 15% new American oak, 70% neutral oak

Bro. When I made the first iteration of this wine, it was slow to take off in popularity. Then, I poured it at a few festivals and I observed that the demographic that loved this wine most was the dudes with the dense beards wearing Pliny the Elder t-shirts. That shifted my perspective, and after tasting it again, I was impressed at how this wine can hold its own among craft beer enthusiasts and wine lovers alike. Aromas and flavors of cappuccino, raspberry, strawberry, sarsaparilla and graphite minerality.


